**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-12-2**

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR GENERAL CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2018, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2019, FOR THE VILLAGE OF ALSIP, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Alsip, Cook County, Illinois:

**Section 1**

**Section 2**

**Section 3**

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

**Section 4**

All statutes of the State of Illinois or any parts thereof which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby superseded by this ordinance enacted under the home rule power of the Village of Alsip.

**Section 5**

This ordinance shall be immediately in full force and effect after passage and approval.


