SAVE ENERGY

CFLs use about 75 percent less energy than traditional standard light bulbs, last about 10 times longer, and each one could save you up to \$52 in energy costs over its lifetime.

LEDs use about 75 percent less energy than traditional standard light bulbs, last about 25 times longer, and each one could save you up to \$194 in energy costs over its lifetime.
