SECURE YOUR HOME FOR SUMMER VACATION

Going on a trip? Take precautions to keep potential intruders away from your property.

- 1. Mail & Newspaper:** Arrange for mail & newspapers to be held while you're away. They can pile up quickly and overflowing mailboxes are a sure sign you are *not* home
 - 2. Alarm System:** Show-off your alarm system by placing an easy to see sign on your door, window, or front lawn.
 - 3. Don't Button up the Whole House:** Secure all doors and windows but leave some drapes and window treatments slightly open. Put some indoor lights on timers.
 - 4. Floodlights:** Invest in motion sensing floodlights for the yard. Glaring light will deter potential intruders
 - 5. Other Quick and Easy ideas:** Leave a radio on in home & car in driveway. Take a walk around your house before you leave and give your house sitter a spare key. *Do not* hide the key under a rock, doormat, or in the BBQ grill. Alert a neighbor, family member or friend that you'll be away, so they can keep an eye on your house.
- Complete a Security Check Report at no cost and patrol officers will perform a daily premise check at your home.**
