The Village of Alsip is requesting Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from IDOT-prequalified engineering firms for Phase II – Design Engineering Services for 131<sup>st</sup> Street from Pulaski Road to Kedzie Avenue. This project is being federally funded, and therefore, consultant selection will be in accordance with the Qualification Based Selection (QBS) guidelines in the Brooks Act (40 USC 11) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requirements for Procurement, Management, and Administration of Engineering and Design Related Services (23 CFR 172). Consultant interviews will be conducted. Consultants will be evaluated in the following areas:

1. Firm's Experience;
2. Team's Experience and Qualifications, including Subconsultants;
3. Key Personnel Expertise / Past Performance, including Subconsultants;
4. Technical Approach to Project and
5. Local Presence.

The Village of Alsip will receive sealed proposals for the following improvements at the Clerk's Office, 4500 West 123rd Street, Alsip, IL, until 10:00 AM on February 16, 2021.

**2021 MANHOLE REHABILITATION**

All proposals shall be sealed in an envelope, addressed to the Village Clerk, Village of Alsip, 4500 West 123<sup>rd</sup> Street, Alsip, Illinois, 60803, and shall be marked with large bold letters "SEALED BID – **2021 MANHOLE REHABILITATION**".

Proposals will be publicly read aloud after 7:30 PM on February 16, 2021. No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the proposals without the consent of the Mayor and Board of Trustees for a period of sixty days after the scheduled time of closing bids.

The Bid Documents, including specifications, are on file at the office of the Engineer, Robinson Engineering, Ltd., (phone 815-806-0300), Email: [reladministrative@reltd.com](mailto:reladministrative@reltd.com), and may be obtained electronically via email upon review of prequalification information. The bid documents will be issued until 4:30 PM on, February 12, 2021.

A bid bond or certified check/bank draft drawn on a solvent bank, payable without condition to the Village of Alsip in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid shall be submitted with each proposal, as a guarantee that, if the proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of the contract is properly secured.

A performance bond in a sum equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the bid, with sureties to be approved by the Mayor and Board of Trustees for the faithful performance of the contract must be furnished by the successful bidder. All bids or proposals shall contain an offer to furnish bond upon acceptance of such bid or proposal.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, to postpone the bid opening, or to advertise for new proposals, if in the judgment of the Mayor and Board of Trustees their best interests will be promoted thereby. All Bids shall remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the time set for opening bids. The Contractor is advised that no work can begin on the project until the District obtains all required permits.

The Contractor will be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates on this project as established by the United States Department of Labor. He shall also comply with all applicable Federal, State and local regulations.

Pre-qualifications will be required to be submitted to the Engineer by all potential bidders. If in the opinion of the Engineer and the Mayor and Board of Trustees, an applicant would not be able to serve the best interest of the District, a proposal will not be issued to the applicant.
