

## LEGAL NOTICE

Board of Fire and Police Commissioners  
Village of Alsip

The Board of Fire and Police Commissioners of the Village of Alsip, Illinois will conduct an examination for the purpose of establishing an eligibility list for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic. The 2016-2017 starting annual salary is \$ 50,000.00 with medical benefits. Beginning Friday, March 11, 2016 applications will be available to qualified applicants on line weekdays and ending on Thursday, March 31, 2016.

Applicants must be at least 21 years of age and must not have attained their 35<sup>th</sup> Birthday by the application filing deadline, be a U.S. citizen, possess a valid driver's license, have a high school diploma or its equivalent, have a current State of Illinois EMT-P License, possess an OSFM Certificate Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter Certificate or Proof of completing a recognized Basic Operations Firefighter Academy ie: NIPSTA and must also possess a CPAT Candidate Physical Ability Test card of not more than 12 months from the date of March 31, 2016, be able to speak, read, and write the English language fluently, and meet such other requirements as set forth by the Illinois Compiled Statutes and the Alsip Fire and Police Commission Rules and Regulations. All firefighters shall reside within the State of Illinois within six (6) months of completion of their probation.

Testing process will consist of the following: Orientation Meeting, Written Test, Oral Interview, Polygraph Test, Background Investigation, and pass a Medical Examination and Drug Screening by a physician designated by the Village of Alsip.

Individuals requiring reasonable accommodation should notify the Commission in writing as soon as possible, with a request, regarding the testing process.

Upon request, additional credit will be given to veterans for military service in accordance with statutory provisions then in force.

Applications **must be** completed with **each** of the following: **Birth Certificate, High School Diploma or GED Certificate, valid Drivers License, current State of Illinois, Illinois Department of Public Health EMT-P License, must possess an OSFM Certificate Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter Certificate or Proof of completing a recognized Basic Operations Firefighter Academy ie: NIPSTA and must also possess a CPAT Candidate Physical Ability Test card of not more than 12 months from the date of March 31, 2016. ADDITIONAL POINTS based on Military, Accredited College Diploma, resident of Alsip, two (2) years of full time (career) firefighting employment by: *Thursday, March 31, 2016 – 4:00 p.m.***

Each applicant is required to pay a \$20.00 application fee to the online service company at the time of application. To apply for an application go to [www.applytoserve.com](http://www.applytoserve.com).

Only applicants who have completed the application and submitted the required documents by the above date will be invited to the mandatory Orientation Meeting to be conducted by the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners on Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Village of Alsip Board Room.
