Electronic Waste – Village of Alsip Residents ONLY

The Village has entered into an agreement for an e-waste curbside collection program with Republic Services of Alsip, starting on January 1, 2021.

Service Details: At the request of a resident, the contractor (Republic Services of Alsip) shall provide e-waste collection services to “cover electronic device(s)” as defined in Section 10 of the Electronic Products Recycling and Refuse Act, 415 ILCS 150/10, no more frequently than **once a month at a date and time scheduled, by the resident through the Contractor by calling 708-385-8252, 48 hours in advance of your regular scheduled day. Only items originating from households are eligible.**

What is considered Electronic Recycling (E-Waste):

Key Electronics Covered by Illinois Law (Banned from Landfills):

- **Computers:** Desktops, laptops, tablets, small-scale servers.
- **Displays:** Monitors (CRT, LCD, LED), Televisions.
- **Peripherals:** Keyboards, mice, printers, scanners, fax machines.
- **Media Players:** Portable digital music players, DVD/Blu-ray players, VCRs.
- **Entertainment:** Video game consoles, cable/satellite receivers, digital converter boxes.

Other Accepted Items (Varies by Location):

- Cell phones, smartphones, modems, power supplies, cables.
- Small appliances (toasters, blenders, vacuums, microwaves, coffee makers).
- Holiday lights, lamps, stereo equipment.

What's Usually NOT Accepted:

- Large appliances (washers, dryers, refrigerators).
- Batteries, smoke detectors, hazardous waste.
- Business electronics (check local rules).

How to Recycle in Illinois:

- **Check Local Resources:** Visit your city or county's waste management website (e.g., Chicago, Naperville, Kane County) for specific drop-off events or permanent centers.
- **Retailer Take-Backs:** Many retailers (like Best Buy) offer recycling for old electronics when you buy new ones.
- **Manufacturer Programs:** Manufacturers are required to fund recycling, so check their websites.
- **Data Security:** Always wipe your devices or use certified recyclers for secure data destruction before dropping them off.
