ILLINOIS — Restaurants and bars across Illinois can begin preparing to reopen at the end of the month if they can provide outdoor seating for customers, with all four regions of the state likely to enter Phase 3 of the Reopen Illinois plan in nine days,

Restaurants and bars can reopen in Phase 3 if they can secure outdoor seating that maintains proper social distancing. Gov Pritzker said, "these services can open at a risk comparable to other outdoor activities." **Employees will be required to wear masks while working,** he said.

"The Village will make tent permits available, provided all provisions are made available to protect the public, please contact the Building Department"

In Phase 3, almost all retail businesses will be allowed to reopen for in-store shopping with capacity and safety restrictions, Pritzker said. **Personal care businesses, like hair and nail salons, barbershops and tattoo studios, can also reopen with new restrictions.** Health clubs and gyms can resume one-on-one training or hold outdoor training sessions with up to 10 people.

All Illinois state parks will reopen on May 29, Boating and camping with up to 10 people are also permitted. **In Phase 3, gatherings of less than 10 people are allowed for any reason, not just essential ones and residents to wear masks when they cannot maintain their distance from others.**

Tennis facilities can reopen with capacity limits and increased safety precautions, and golf course will be allowed to permit four players at the same tee time. Golfers will once again be able to use carts if they are alone or with members of their household, the governor said.
