The Village of Alsip would like to remind everyone of its 1979 ordinance re:

SNOW REMOVAL- RESTRICTIONS

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle on a public street designated as a snow route as listed below:

- (a) **Primary Snow Route.** It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on primary snow routes in the Village at any time within twelve (12) hours after a snowfall of one inch or more has occurred. *Appropriate signs shall be erected to inform the public of primary routes.*



- (b) **Secondary Snow Route.** It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on secondary snow routes in the Village at any time within twenty-four (24) hours after a snowfall of three (3) inches or more has occurred. *Secondary snow routes are defined as all other public streets not designated as primary snow routes.*



- (c) **Removal of Vehicles.** The police department or its designated representative shall remove any vehicle from the public street, obstructing the clearing of said public street after a snowfall of three (3) inches or more. The towing and storage charges or relocation fees for said vehicle shall be charged to the registered owner of the vehicle and constitute a lien upon said vehicle.
