Village of Alsip Residents & Businesses,

Cook County Department of Public Health issued a Mitigation Order, effective Jan. 3, 2022, in response to the recent COVID-19 surge in case counts and hospitalizations, **Cook County has determined that mitigation measures are necessary to protect the public health, by ordering the following:**

All Businesses and Individuals:

Any individual aged two and older and able to medically tolerate a mask shall be required to wear a mask when indoors in a public place, regardless of vaccination status.

Indoor settings where food or drink are served for on-premises consumption, and health and fitness centers:

- **Businesses must require any individual 5 years of age and older to show proof that they are fully-vaccinated against COVID-19 with an approved vaccine in order to enter the establishment.**
- Businesses must require Patrons age 16 and older to show identification (including but not limited to driver's license, passport, government ID, work or school ID) with information that corresponds to the vaccination proof.
- Businesses must post signage advising patrons of this vaccine requirement.
- Employees must be vaccinated or must weekly show proof of a negative COVID-19 test.
- Businesses must develop a written protocol providing details for how they will enforce this Order.

Exemptions – Individuals:

- 1. Individuals entering an establishment for less than 10 minutes for ordering and carrying out food; making a delivery; or using restroom facilities.**
- 2. An individual 18 years of age or younger who enters a business subject to this Order to participate in a school activity or after-school program offered by any pre-kindergarten through 12th grade public or non-public school.**
- 3. Any person entering a business subject to this Order for the purposes of voting in a municipal, state, or federal election; or, pursuant to law, assisting or accompanying a voter or observing such elections.**
