The Cook County Department of Public Health has rescinded Mitigation Order 2021-11, which lifts the vaccination and masking requirements for suburban Cook County jurisdictions.



Masking is still necessary as a part of isolation, following an infection and quarantine after any COVID-19 exposure to prevent further transmission. This includes workplace and schools.

Masks are still required in airports and interstate transportation (buses) by federal order, including healthcare facilities, clinics, and long-term care facilities, in accordance with the Illinois Department of Public Health & CDC guidance.
