- <u>Citizenship</u>: Must be a U.S. Citizen
- <u>Driver's License</u>: Must possess a valid Driver's License at the time of application with the ability to obtain an Illinois Driver's License upon time of hire.
- <u>Age Requirement</u>: Applicant must be at least 20 years old and under the age of 35 years old at the last date of filing applications (5/25/23) and at such time as the final eligibility list is posted, unless exempt by State Statute 65 IL 5/10-2.1-6., which

provides in part that the age limitation does not apply to any person previously employed as a Certified (full-time) Law Enforcement Officer in a municipality in the United States. Applicants must have attained their 20st birthday by the last date for filing applications 5/25/2023.

- *Education:* Must have proof of High School Diploma or GED Certificate.
